METHYLOMIC Project Highlights:

- ❖ One significant achievement for the success of the METHYLOMIC Project is the completion of the final **assay development** step comprising the dry run to test and document the entire workflow, from patient sample collection to therapy feedback. This standardized workflow is a critical part of the **OmiCrohn Clinical Trial** which is expected to start in the third quarter of 2024. Thanks to all contributing partners for their hard work, under the stewardship of Amsterdam UMC, we successfully completed the Crohn's Disease assay development and workflow.
- ❖ Another important milestone relates to the submission of the clinical study protocols for the EIPSORA trial that assess therapy response prediction in rheumatoid arthritis and psoriasis. We expect final approvals for these studies in the third quarter of 2024.
- ❖ **We contacted patient organizations** to invite them to be patient partners of the METHYLOMIC Consortium, within the EIPSORA trial. **We hope for their positive answer!**

- ❖ Get ready for the **first annual online METHYLOMIC stakeholder workshop organized by EFCCA**. This two-hour workshop, **designed for patients**, will feature an **interactive discussion on Artificial Intelligence in Medicine** and is scheduled for **October 2024**.
